

PROTESTS

1. Rider protests, such as complaints of course cutting, un-sportsman-like conduct, etc., must be made first to a Track Official.
2. Protest must be made by a member in good standing.
3. Any infraction of a rule or dispute over finishing position must be made within twenty (20) minutes of their last moto.
4. All protests, whether a rider, machine, or rule violations, must be clearly written and must be presented only to the Referee or Track Official and must be accompanied by a PROTEST FEE of \$25.00. If the protest is found valid, the PROTEST FEE will be returned to the person making a protest. If the protest is not valid, the PROTEST FEE will be forfeited and given to the person under protest. An Official may protest without any fee.
5. **Any Interruption of the SCOREKEEPERS during a race with a protest or complaints is grounds for DISQUALIFICATION.**
